

- 1 The purpose of this Technology Security Program is to provide an overview of the policies, standards and procedures that make up Chattanooga State Community College's (ChSCC) Technology Security Program.
- 2 The Technology Security Program establishes guidelines and principles for initiating, implementing, maintaining, and improving technology security management for ChSCC. The program is intended to protect the confidentiality, integrity and availability of technology resources.
- 3 Policies are high-level statements of principle that provide technology direction to the College community. Due to the nature of technology requirements, Technology Policies may contain compliance standards for the College as a whole.
- 4 The focus of security awareness at ChSCC is aimed at creating an attitude of commitment to good security practices and facilitating a climate that sees security rules as beneficial to the protection of the College environment.
- 5 Users formally acknowledge their responsibilities through the acceptance of a statement on the terms of use of technology resources upon their logon to their ChSCC account.
- 6 Policy development is driven by CHSCC directives, new legislation and regulations, audit findings, risk assessment and College strategic planning and initiatives.
- 7 Technology Division has 16 overarching policies at ChSCC level. Technology Division's procedures and processes are written as necessary to provide guidance on implementing the policies.
